December Meeting minutes presented. Shannon Cannon made a motion to accept the minutes. Motion was seconded by Jonna Belshaw. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: *Cindy Grabo:* Around \$1800 was made on "Evening With The Band". Tammy suggested possibly having in the future, a column of the previous years' figures on the monthly profit & loss statements and assets sheets in order to use as comparison. A motion to accept the Treasurer's report was made by Jonna Belshaw and seconded by Suzanne Martin. Motion passed.

Committee Reports

GFS: Mention that you are from Midview Band Boosters to cashier when checking out & the Boosters will receive quarterly checks from GFS based on sales of items marked "Points Earned".

Concession: *Matt & Roberta Plas:* Concession invoice from Pepsi was paid off & it was less than anticipated, so final profit total for concession is \$19,640.

Apparel: *Sue Lawwill:* \$121 was made at the Christmas Concert. UnderArmour sale may be placed earlier next season (Aug-early Sept.) There have been no ring orders thus far.

An Evening With The Band: *Coreen Joviak:* 182 seats were sold for total of \$910, \$785 was made on the basket raffle, & \$120 profit in poinsettia sales. We will forgo taking pictures next year as we only sold 3 for \$9 profit. We heard many compliments from those attending, thanks to all who helped make it a success!

Night At The Races: *Tammy Koleski:* Feb 27th, 2016. Sue L. has contacted over 100 businesses for basket donations, and she is waiting for replies. A request was made of \$50 by Sue to pay for postage for donation letters that must be mailed. It was also suggested that we establish a budget for food so that we can know in advance what we will be offering and the load of food prep is not a burden to parents. Tammy suggested \$500 food budget to start. A motion to allow both of these requests was made by Jonna Belshaw & seconded by April Foster. Jonna offered to check with Bob Evans to see if they would donate 150 servings of green beans & potatoes for the event even if we had to purchase the same amount. Also checking with Olive Garden for salad & breadstick donation in the same manner. Koleski's will once again be supplying the chicken paprikash. April will contact the vendor we used for beer last year & also check with Coca Cola about a possible pop & water donation. We need to push ticket sales! Look for the event on facebook coming from Tammy that you can share with friends. Also there are things you can do to help if you do not want to gamble. Josh will contact Rural-Urban to post the event every other week for 3 weeks.

Directors' Reports

Ms. Fieger: In process of doing Lo. Cty. Middle School Honors auditions. We are collecting forms for the Lo. Cty. Solo & Ensemble. About 30 signed up thus far. Band dance is Fri, Feb 5th. We are in need of a new frame for the orchestra bells at the middle school, so we will be getting an estimate.

Mr. Brunger: A printed version of the Band Booster By-laws was passed out to those present this evening. It hasn't been updated since 2011 & needs to be, thus we will plan to meet at 6:30pm prior to the April 7th Booster meeting to revise the by-laws. We have 2 guest artists, Gary Adams & Diana Seybold working with the students & there has been noticeable improvement. For the band trip in May, we are in the process of making room assignments for students (4 per room) and chaperones (2 per room). The 2016 FB season is posted on Charms & rest will be added soon.

Band President Report : *VP Johnny Koleski:* For the Band dance we are requesting \$400 for the DJ and \$100 for decorations. There is no theme yet. Josh Brunger made a motion to allow the funds and motion was seconded by Sue Lawwill. Motion passed. Parents please email Mr. B. if you would like to chaperone this event.

New Business : It was suggested that a nomination team be put together to nominate the 2016-17 board.
