Committee Reports

Apparel: *Sue Lawwill:*

- New shirts have been designed for Pep and Jazz bands and orders will be taken this month.
- Apparel sales for September totaled \$527, with \$150 at the Parade of Bands.
- Midview Under Armour® apparel will be available this month, orders taken to Nov 15.
- The loading ramp to help with the apparel cart is on back order.

Concessions: *Matt Plas*

- September was a good month, net profit - \$15756. We met our budget for the year (\$15000) with two games still to play in October.
- We will be working the three remaining JV football games and the Powder Puff game Oct. 20. Goal is \$150 - \$200/game.

Gold Cards: *Melissa Keating:*

- Card sales are still coming in, total to date is \$11020; our goal is \$12000.

Parade of Bands:

- Janet has volunteered to send out Thank You letters to the PoB sponsors and donors.
- Matt would like to meet and collect everyone's documents, artwork and other information for next year.

Directors' Reports

Ms. Besand:

- Pleased with the Middle School progress, there is a lot of interest in French horns.
- Several of the Middle School bassoons are in need of repair, quotes for two repairs total \$625, and the third repair cost is more than the value of the instrument and will be scrapped.
- Requested funds for two bassoon cases @ \$160 each. Jonna Belshaw made a motion to approve \$320 for the cases, motion passed.
- Applied for grants to help purchase of new music stands and 2 chair racks.

Mr. Brunger:

- The new Marching Blue uniform design is nearly complete, the cost will be approximately \$340 each depending on the final design and a cash discount. Cost for 150 uniforms will be about \$51000. The new uniform design will be presented at the Oct 27th School Board meeting.
- The current raincoats/parkas are deteriorating and some are beyond cleaning or repair. New coats would cost about \$77 each, 150 needed.
- Senior Night is Oct 21st thanks to everyone who donated and volunteered for this event.
- OMEA District VII Honors Festival is Nov 10-12 at Cleveland State, there are several participation fees.
- Considering reprinting the Band photos which surround the Band Room in a smaller, uniform format to allow room for future photos.
- First Jazz Band performance will be at the Belden Chili Cook-Off at the fire station Oct. 29.
- Jazz Band will also perform at the IX Center Christmas Connection, Nov. 18 at 1 pm.
- The 2018 Band trip will be to Virginia Beach in April.

Presidents Report:

- Looking for an accountant to handle our IRS 990 filing, due Nov. 15.
- A letter of thanks from Midview graduate and scholarship recipient Brad Hetrick was read and entered into the record.
