October meeting minutes presented. Suzanne Martin made a motion to accept the minutes. Motion was seconded Sue Lawwill Motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** *Melissa Keating:* The band received an anonymous donation of \$5000 on Oct 24<sup>th</sup>. Paid \$400 in fees to the State of Ohio AG for late registration. A job description for the treasurer position has been documented. We are looking for someone to start shadowing the treasurer and to take over the job after the 2017-2018 school year. A motion was brought to the table to keep the current CD for next year's deposit for future uniform purchases. Tim Gallagher made the motion to accept. Motion was seconded by Tammy Koleski.

Sue Lawwill made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Motion was seconded by Tim Gallagher. Motion passed.

### Committee Reports

**Apparel:** *Sue Lawwill:* Sold \$531 at the Marching Band Concert. Invoice needs paid to apparel vendor in order to place order for Jazz Band and Pep Band T-shirts.

**Concession:** *Matt Plas:* Concession season ends tomorrow with the playoff game. Powder Puff game raised \$119. Three JV games raised \$729. T&D Kettle Korn will return next year. Our share was about \$100/game. Our profit so far this year is \$21,000. We have a possible lead for someone to take over concessions next year.

**Evening with the Band:** *Coreen Joviak:* We are going to stay with 23 round tables this year. Will evaluate if the demand is high and could possibly add a few more tables. Flyers will go home with students on November 8<sup>th</sup>. Need volunteers to sign up in Charms.

**Night at the Races:** *Tammy Koleski:* Date is set for March 4<sup>th</sup>. Contacting Kohl's Cares for help with event. Looking for a big turnout this year as this is a great fundraiser for us.

### Directors' Reports

**Ms. Besand:** Sixth, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Holiday Concert is December 8<sup>th</sup> at 7pm. Band Boosters will be there to support. Received Nordson Grant of \$900 to purchase new stands. Twenty three 8<sup>th</sup> graders volunteered to play for grand friend's day. Current number of bands in each grade are: 6<sup>th</sup> – 114, 7<sup>th</sup> – 54, and 8<sup>th</sup> - 47. In need of a lock box for the middle school band office to help with collecting money from students. Rachel Carter volunteered to have one made. There is a middle school parent possibly interested in running the concession stands next year.

**Mr. Brunger:** The new uniform design was presented at the October School Board meeting. The old uniforms will be gifted back to the Band Boosters for resale/donation. Ready to order uniforms in December. Total cost is approx. \$60k for 150 uniforms, coats and garment bags (not including pants). After discussion the uniform quantity was raised to 160 for additional \$4k. Motion was made to order 160 uniforms by Tim Gallagher and was seconded by Tammy Koleski. Band Boosters will take old uniforms and have them turned into pillows to sell. Nov 15<sup>th</sup> is the Band Banquet and awards will be given out. OMEA Honors is Nov 10-12 at CSU. 10 Students from Midview are going. Concert is 4pm at CSU. Jazz band has performed their first event and sounded great. Basketball season is upon us and band students must perform at 4 Basketball games as it counts for a grade. The 2018 band trip is being planned. We are going to Norfolk and Virginia Beach April 27-30<sup>th</sup>. Approx cost will be \$624 for 3 nights. Cost could go down if we fill all 3 buses.

**Old Business:** Senior night cost \$730. With the budget and donations we had \$610. Sue Lawwill would like to be reimbursed for the difference of \$120. Motion to accept made by Rachel Carter and seconded by Tim Gallagher. We had double the amount of seniors as in the past this year. We should re-evaluate our budget amount for next season.

**New Business:** *Matt Plas:* We are registered with Kohl's Cares which is Kohl's volunteer service program. We are working with Kevin Decaire of Bottom Line Accounting to file tax form 990 due Nov 15<sup>th</sup>.
