Treasurer's Report: *Melissa Keating:* (Matt Plas) Reviewed November financial statement. Payment has been made for 160 uniforms, raincoats, hat boxes and accessories totaling \$62,777.05. The uniforms are paid in full, MBB total assets after payment - \$63089. Leah Prunty made a motion to accept the treasurer's. Seconded by Bob Lawwill. Motion passed.

Evening with the Band: *Coreen Joviak:* Decided to go with 27 tables this year and we are sold out. We sold 65 poinsettias. Set up will begin at 4:30 on Dec 12th.

Night at the Races: *Tammy Koleski:* Date is set for March 4th. Venue has changed to American Legion 717 (Bender Road) for more room. We are hoping for 5-10 volunteers through Kohl's Cares Volunteer Program to work the event.

Directors' Reports

Ms. Besand: Programs done for Middle school concert. Band Boosters will be promoted and talked about at concert. Facebook page created – Midview Intermediate and Middle School Bands. District 4 Honors Band is in March. 8 students can be nominated. Ms. Besand is asking the boosters pay for the \$20 that each student will have to pay. Sue Lawwill made motion to pay the student's fees up to \$160. Leah Prunty seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Mr. Brunger: Percussion will have ensemble in the band concert on Dec 12th. Pep band starts Dec 9th. Students must perform at 4 games. Jazz band has been very busy. They performed at the IX Center. The IX Center then donated \$150 to the group. There may be a need to order more black uniform pants as the enrollment in marching band could be 144 students next year. Mr. B getting quotes on pants. Solo Ensemble and OMEA fees must be paid by students before winter break.
