Treasurer's Report: *Melissa Keating:* Reviewed April financial statement. \$18,040 has been collected from students so far for the 2018 band trip. The board of transportation bill has been paid. The 2017-2018 Budget was presented. Bob Lawwill made the motion to approve the budget. Motion was seconded by Leah Prunty. Motion Passed. Leah Prunty made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Motion was seconded by Jenny Clark. Motion passed.

Committee Reports

Apparel: *Sue Lawwill:* Looking for new t-shirt designs for 2017-2018 season

Concession: *Matt Plas:* Still looking for someone to co-chair running concessions for next season. Leah Prunty and Roberta Plas will be running the band barn for 2017-2018 season.

Scholarships: Band scholarships will be awarded to two graduating seniors \$1000 each. Applications are still being accepted. Summer enrichment scholarships are also being reviewed. 3 of them have been received so far. 2 for Baldwin Wallace and 1 for Fred J Miller camp.

Fundraising Reports

Parade of Bands: Date for POB is September 23, 2017. Still need someone to be chairperson for this event. They have the following bands confirmed that they are coming: Columbia, Clearview, North Ridgeville, Elyria, and Brookside. Need to get with Lora Kilgore for the program files. Next parade of bands meeting will be at 6:30 before next meeting booster meeting.

Directors' Reports

Ms. Besand: May 18th is the next Middle School band concert being held at the high school. Parents are needed to count the number of attendees. Also would like the apparel cart there. The mock adjudicated event went really well. 7th and 8th grade both were over rated as a 2. Project Double Horn – students at East currently use a single French horn and when they get to the middle school, it changes to a double French horn. This is confusing for musicians. Looking to replace 7 single French horns with new double French horns. Cost could be \$2000-\$5000 each. This would be on the 2017-2018 budget. No motion was made. Need quotes with final costs.

Mr. Brunger: We are able to get 300 pillows from the old uniforms. Selling them for \$40 each. Orders forms will go out closer to when the pillows arrive. Senior dinner is May 23rd at CiCi's. Summer uniform may get changed to blue shirts and black shorts since the uniform shoes are changing to black. Interviews are done for drum majors/auxiliary captain. Picture frames are needed for the senior photos. Kim Lambert will pick up. Details for Memorial Day and Graduation went home with students. Schedule for next year is almost ready and posted on Charms. 8th graders are getting packets with all important info about what to expect for high school band. A parent orientation meeting has been set up for July 31. This is for all grades and incoming members. New uniforms are here. There were 2 broken hats and 2 broken boxes. The extra black pants that were needed were ordered. Aug 5th is Elyria's bicentennial parade and we will be marching. Aug 11th is Fall picture day.

Old Business: Election of officers is final: President – Matt Plas, Vice President – Leah Prunty, Secretary – Jenny Clark, Treasurer – Melissa Keating. Still looking for an assistant treasurer. The final cost for the band room television was \$1200. Percussion cabinet that was approved will be on the budget for 2017-2018 year.

New Business: Coreen Joviak spoke about "spring cleaning" and sending out a form for anyone who would like donate or sell their old instrument or clothing to the incoming students. Mr B and Ms Besand will get the information out to the students. Kaitlynne Leimbach received final costs for new auxiliary uniforms. Final cost will be \$566.50. Sue Lawwill made the motion to purchase the new uniforms. Motion was seconded by Bob Lawwill. Motion passed.
