  - Melissa Keating Secretary: The Secretary shall keep a complete record of all proceedings of all meetings of the organization and a list of all members thereof and shall attend to all correspondence of the organization and shall furnish names of the committees to their respective chairpersons The Secretary shall distribute a written agenda, file the organization's documents on the website and storage hard drive. The Secretary shall also perform such other duties as usually pertain to their office, or as may be assigned by the President.
