Committee Reports

GFS: Just mention that you are from Midview Band Boosters to cashier when checking out & the Boosters will receive quarterly checks from GFS based on sales of items marked "Points Earned".

Concession: Matt & Roberta Plas: Playoff game concession sales were a big success @ \$6,000. We started selling out of some items by 7:30pm. Thus early sales are key. Thank you to Koleskis for making their paprikas which also sold out. Also, thank you to all of the volunteers that worked the concession stand this year. Another successful year with 2015 proceeds to the band = \$ 18,643. A breakdown sheet for 2015 was submitted showing income & expenses and numbers of items sold. As per Mr. Goggin, we have ended our 7 year contract with Pepsi & booster groups are free to purchase any soft drinks on their own or use the option of ordering Pepsi products through the kitchen at Sodexo's prices, saving us \$3-8 per case. Pepsi coolers will stay & continue to be maintained by Pepsi. All products in the Pepsi cooler must be Pepsi products only.

Apparel: Sue & Bob Lawwill: A total of \$1700 was previously requested and authorized by the board to buy new apparel & \$1611.80 was spent on such. \$667 of apparel was sold in 2 days of the School's Santa Shop. Window decals are now available for \$5 and in the Spring personalized seat cushions will be made available to order. We have the opportunity to sell personalized Stainless Steel rings (made by an outside source, "Bob the Ring Man") @ \$20 per ring on which the Band would profit \$3 per ring. A motion to allow this sale, in 2 time frames, (now through Christmas and again in January for February delivery) was made by Melissa Keating and seconded by Jonna Belshaw. Motion passed.

An Evening With The Band: Coreen Joviak: Monday, Dec. 14th during the Band concert. Mr. Brunger will request 7 Tri-M Choir members to help volunteer that evening. Set-up will begin at 4:30pm. Donated desserts and raffle baskets should arrive no later than 6pm. Please see Charms for opportunities to help.

Night At The Races: Tammy Koleski: Feb 27th, 2016. We have had a venue change from last year. The new venue will be The American Legion Post 12 on Gulf Rd/Ohio St., Elyria. Melissa Keating will contact Kohl's Kares to see if they will send volunteers to work this event for us and possibly a donation. Sue Lawwill will mail donation request letters to various other places. Info packets will be sent home with students before Christmas Break.

A request is made for the purchase of 15 t-shirts to be purchased for the Middle School Honors Band.
