Marching Blue Percussion: (Chris Hickman, 11th grade drumline)

Prices ranged from \$10-\$28 per pair. This year they paid for rim covers and stick bags for the whole section. Cost \$13/bag, \$20/rim saver, plus \$30-\$40 per mallet rack, and they need 5 of them. Sellers of tickets can be anyone in the district. Top seller will appear in a grand illusion and get \$100 cash.
 - o Magician Rick Smith Jr will be at the Midview Elementary schools on September 22nd to promote the show. Rick Smith is in Guinness book of World Records for card throwing.
