Trombone – wants to replace case for stolen trombone, \$172.65 for case and 38.50 for mouthpiece. Locks for 157 lockers with \$5 locks. Total of \$785. Middle School Principal John Brown has declined to cover the cost.

Nordson Grant Application: For a jazz band drum set - \$645. Lisa Radke has a drum set to donate if the grant is denied. Middle school jazz band has started! Some music theory and improvisation, about 40 members. Will be playing while parents are waiting to come in.

6th grade Band - 82 students came to lessons. Expecting 14 more...Possible 96. 205 students in the 6th grade=47% signed up for band.

Project Double Horn: Four French horns from Hampson Horns (Dr. James Hampson) have been offered at \$1350 each, three Conn 6Ds and one Olds. Total is \$5400, requesting approval for purchase.

Scale Rhythm and Chunks: Challenged 7th and 8th graders to do bronze level. Sarah Sheldon came in first (with Ally Clark a close second). Star pins are available for purchase, replacing Band Ninja. 110 kids in MMS program. We are ordering stars.

OMEA: Six or seven students got accepted into OMEA Honors.

Gold Cards: trying to put it on charms.

Senior night next week: 30 flower corsage bills for senior night. Will send out email for volunteers and donations.

Uniform pillows: \$40. Selling order: Last year's seniors, this year's juniors and seniors.

One More Time Concert: District website is still not working. Our web page is correct- October 26th at 7:00. There is a football game ahead of time.
