Directors' Reports:

Ms. Crayton

- ~ **Andrew Schmidt** – Elementary music teacher who will be taking over as MMS director
- ~ **Jazz Band** – Looking to expand Jazz and Java into the Grafton Midview Jazz Festival
- ~ **2022 Marching Show** – Band on the Run, one theme with 5 songs instead of 3 different shows.
- ~ **July 25th Orientation** – Tina will put together a post card of the 2022-23 calendar dates; Possibly get Tara from Check Please to sponsor; use for 5th & 6th grade orientation as well, date TBD
- ~ **Band Room Refresh** – School will provide the paint; need student/parent volunteers.
- ~ **Instrument Repairs** – Quote pending on 24 - 28 instruments sent for repairs; some will likely be retired
- ~ **Instrument Purchases** – 2 silver melophones (\$2300 each), 1 half weight Pearl Tenors (\$1300) + \$240/\$390 for stand and back bar, drum heads (\$17.50/\$40), Pearl mallet station (\$1300).
- ~ **Percussion Cabinet** – Estimated at \$2000; also need stand tune packets.

- ~ **Instrument Purchase Estimates** – Approximately \$17,000
 - o Bassoon (1) Estimate \$5,445
 - o Flutes (5) - Regularly \$989, on sale \$593; Reg. Est. = \$4,945; Sale Est. = \$2,965; SAVE \$1,980
 - o Alto Saxophones (3) Estimate = \$9,000
- ~ **Grants** – Applied for stand racks
